INFORMATION ABOUT REGULATION RELATED TO THE REMOVAL OR MAINTENANCE OF TREES

City Property:

Any work on trees on city property requires permission from the city and the city may elect to perform the work themselves. If you are not aware of your property boundaries, a good map reference can be found under your address at www.dial.deschutes.com

Private Property:

Coyote Springs Homeowners Association:

Coyote Springs Homeowners Association Covenants and Restrictions require that *no tree over four inches in diameter, major shrub, large rock or other prominent vegetation or natural feature shall be removed from a homesite without the express written consent of the DRC.*

City of Sisters Requirements:

City Ordinance 534 requires a permit for the removal of any tree on private property measuring 8" in diameter or greater measured at 4.5 feet above ground. See City Hall for a permit.
