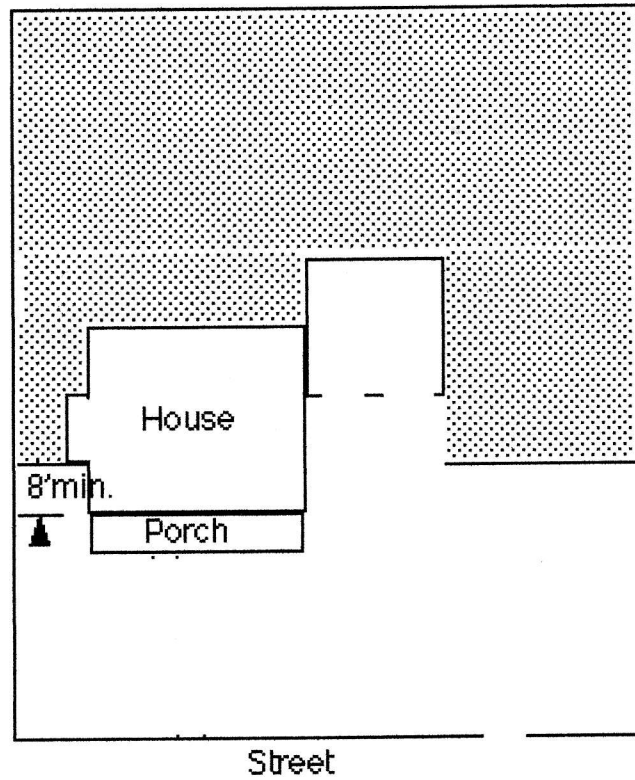
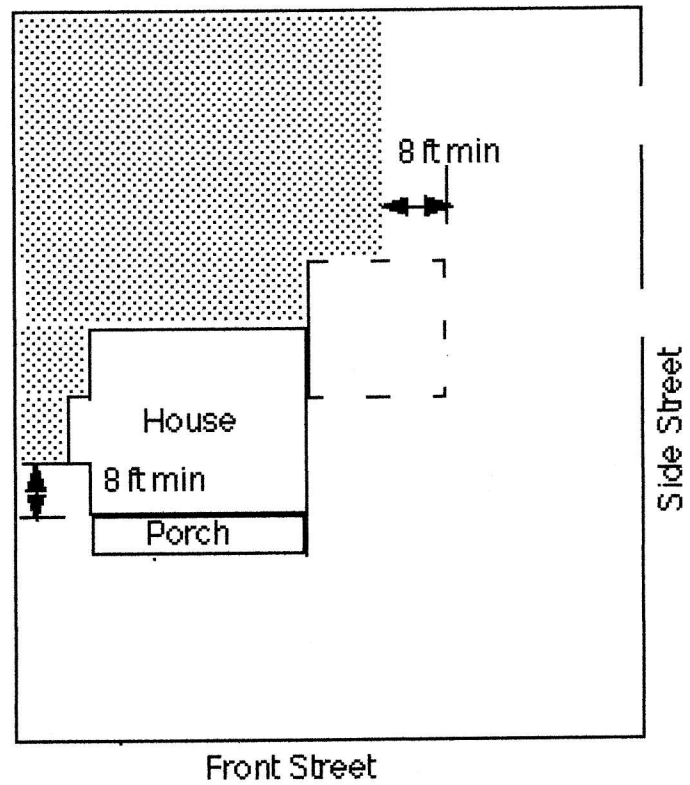


## **Appendix D - Fences**

Example 1 - Fences in the shaded area only.



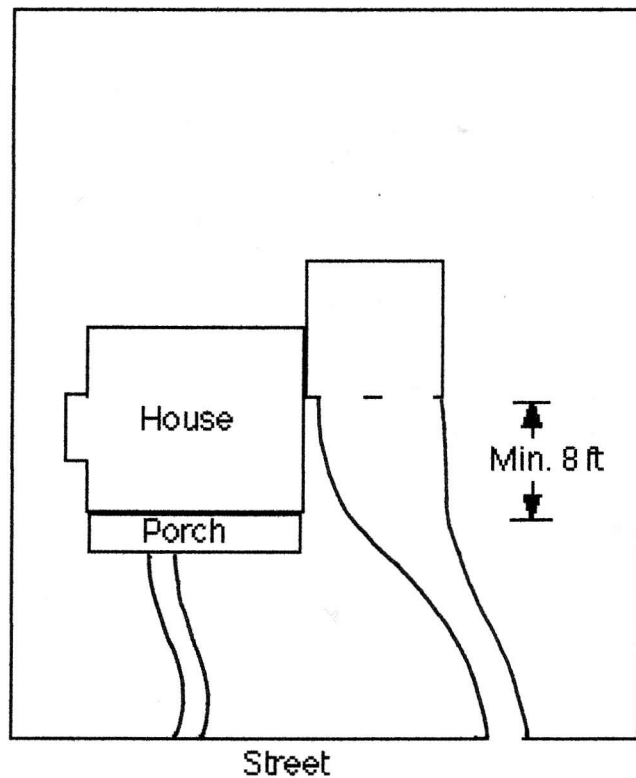
Example 2 - corner lot - Fences in the shaded area only.



**Appendix E** - Garages and Driveways

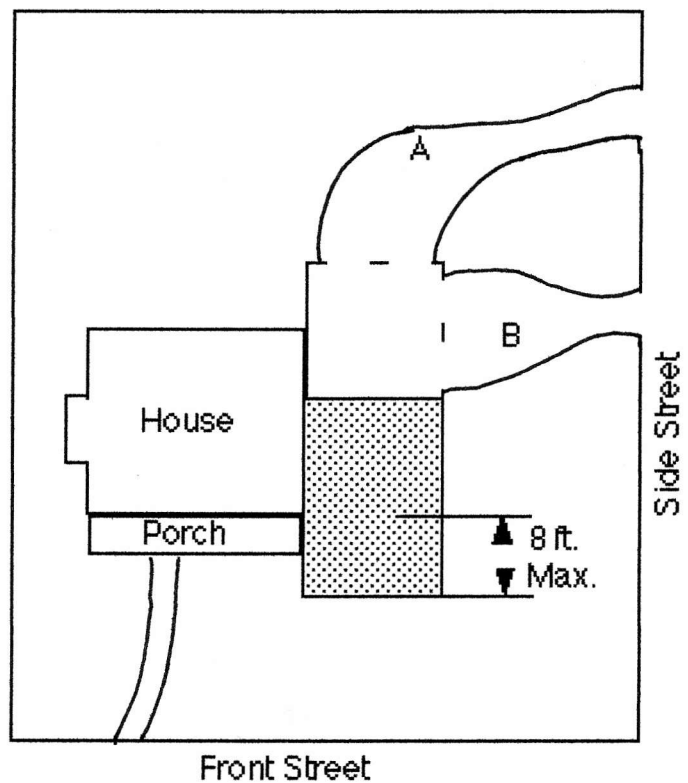
**Example 1** - garage doors face the street

The face of the garage is set back a minimum of 8 ft. from the face of the house.



**Example 2** - corner lot, drive on side street

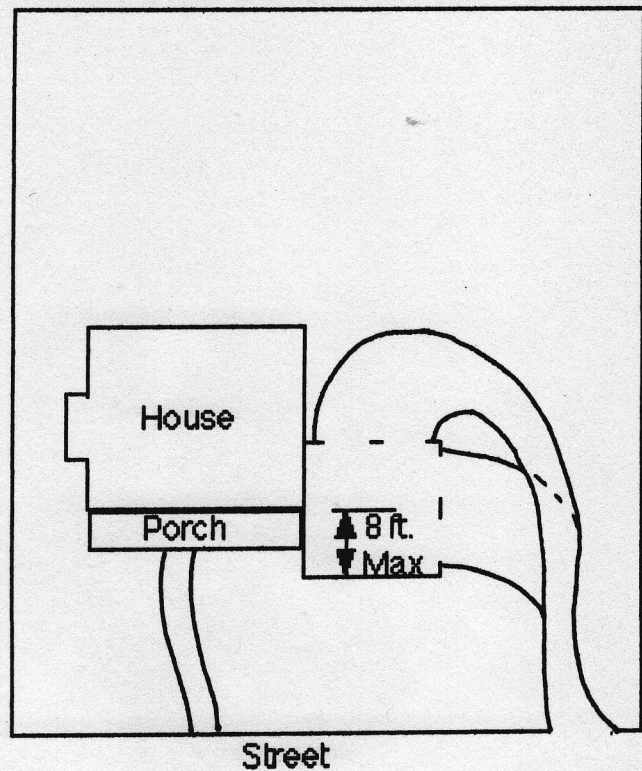
On a corner lot, either A or B will work and the garage could be back further on the lot or move forward into the shaded area. If the driveway were to enter from the street in front, the other examples apply.



**Example 3 - garage closer to the street**

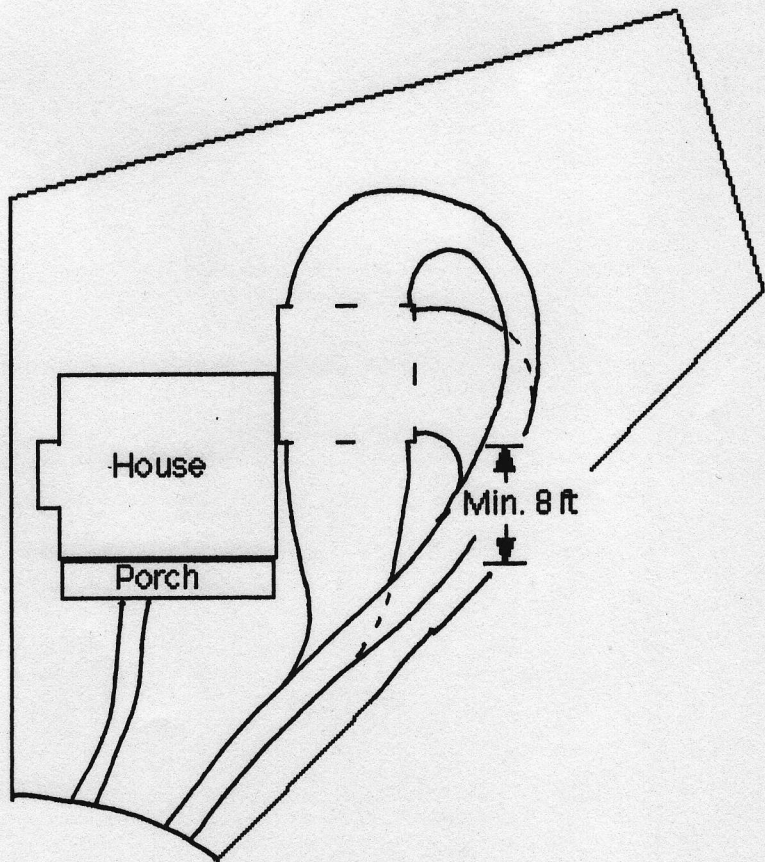
In this case the garage doors cannot face the street.

It would be better if the garage were back further, relative to the house.



**Another Example 4**

In this case, with the garage back, any of the three driveway locations could work, or possibly example 3 above if the garage were recessed less than 8 ft.
